## 1. Instructions on protection of intellectual property for materials available at the NETCHEM platform

Based on the discussion held at the NETCHEM Work Meeting in Niš, on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2018, and NETCHEM Work Meeting in Paris, on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2018, the following guidelines related to the material prepared in the framework of the NETCHEM project, published at the related websites (i.e. [netchem.ac.rs](http://netchem.ac.rs), [database.netchem-eu.com](http://database.netchem-eu.com), [mdl.netchem.ac.rs](http://mdl.netchem.ac.rs), [netchem-eu.com](http://netchem-eu.com), etc), are set:

1. Created material in the form of documents/presentations (static material) i.e. laboratory guides, lectures etc. **must include the project logo, EU Commission disclaimer text and Erasmus+ logo**, at least on the first and the last page/slide. Each author must be acknowledged on the first slide of the presentation. The logos (Erasmus+, institutional and project) should be visible in all slides.

NETCHEM consortium members are obliged to follow the rules set by EACEA in the following link:

2. Created video material i.e. laboratory video instructions, video-clips must contain all project related information as mentioned in section 1.

For example, the first 5-10 seconds of dynamic/video material should contain the same information as the first slide of the static material with logo and text as described in (1). During the entire duration of the video, the project's logos must be visible in the top right corner.

The last 5-10 seconds of the video material, should be preferably like the last 1-2 slides in the static presentation (laboratory guide), see template link within point 1.

**for the original creation.**
